Why consider going abroad for student exchange?

- Opens up your horizons to international perspectives and new cultures
- Grows your network further through international connections
- Looks great on your CV
- Gives you the unique opportunity to study at another university
- Gives you the opportunity to learn (or improve) a foreign language

Who can go? When can you go? Where can you go?

- Most UG students can go during 2nd Semester of Year 2.
- International Marketing students will go for 2 semesters during their 3rd year.
- Some degree programmes are not suitable for international exchange (talk to our exchange coordinator to find out) and you can, then, consider summer schools during the summer of Year 1 or Year 2.

How to apply for international exchange?

- Express an interest by contacting our exchange coordinator Dr Katia Pina: Katia.Oliveira-Pina@soton.ac.uk
 - Do this as soon as possible in Semester 1 and no later than 08 January 2018 (**no applications will be considered after this date**)
- Your average marks for Semester 1 should be min 2:1 (i.e. min 60%) to qualify
- Visit the International Office desk at the Opportunities Fair that will be organised later in Semester 1.
- Attend Business School events organised by the exchange coordinator (these will be emailed to you at your university email address).
- Think about which university you want to go to and look at the modules they offer.
- Discuss this option with your families, personal tutors and our exchange coordinator.
